STATEMENT

Posadas and its brands *Live Aqua*, *Grand Fiesta Americana*, *Fiesta Americana*, *Fiesta Inn*, *Gamma*, *One Hoteles* and *The Exploreal by Fiesta Americana*, report that, following the earthquake that took place on September 19, and affected Mexico City, the State of Mexico, and the states of Puebla and Morelos, carried out all the corresponding safety protocols recommended by civil protection authorities to safeguard the integrity of all guests, clients, and staff members.

Likewise, we confirm that the hotels in the affected areas continue to operate normally, except for *Fiesta Americana San Antonio el Puente*, located in the State of Morelos; however, authorities are currently conducting the corresponding assessments to be able to determine the actual state of this premise.

The safety of all our guests, clients, and staff members is a top priority for *Posadas*; therefore, we will continue monitoring the reports and recommendations issued by civil protection, to be able to communicate and apply these immediately if necessary.

We express our support to all affected families, and we confirm that all reservations booked in the hotels located in the affected areas (Mexico City, the State of Mexico, and the states of Puebla and Morelos) can be cancelled at no charge until further notice.
